### ➤ Stage 1

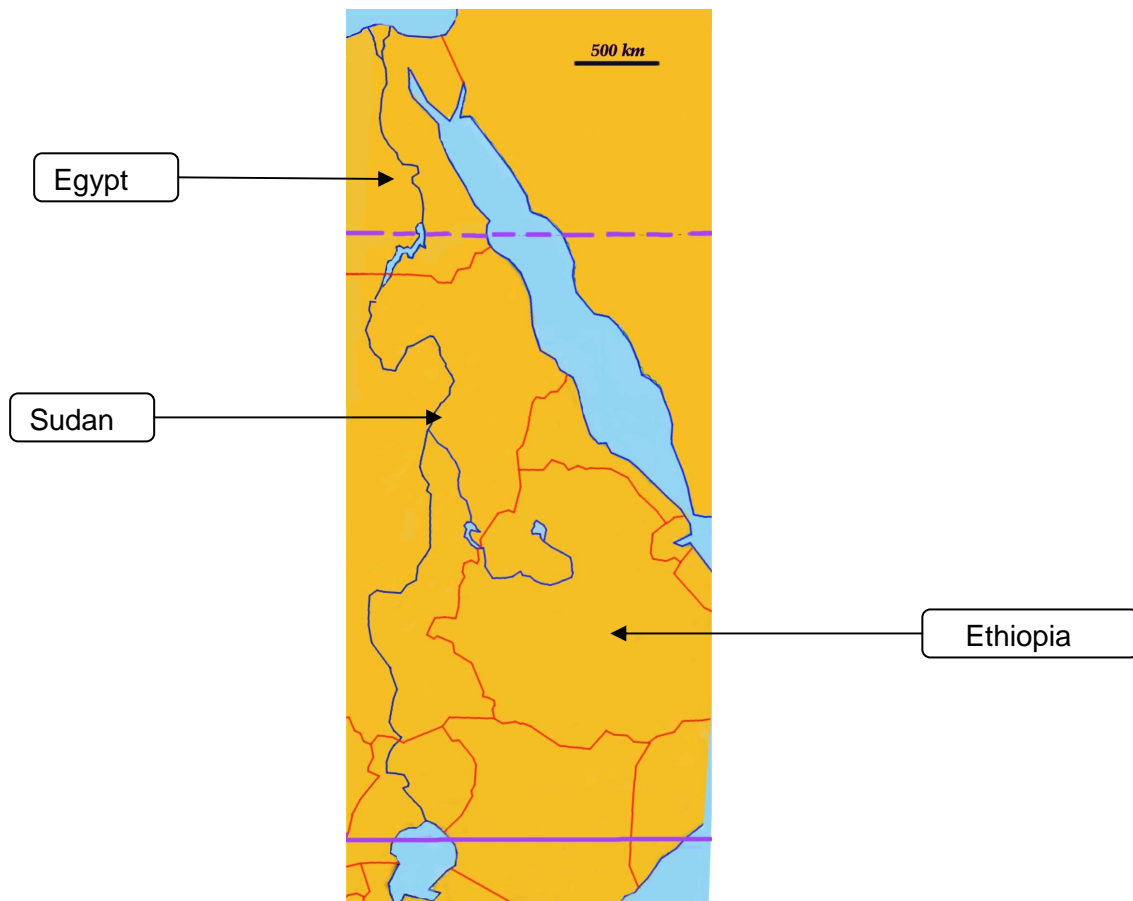
 *The attraction is in theatre 1 indicated on the map below.*

Fly me to the Moon



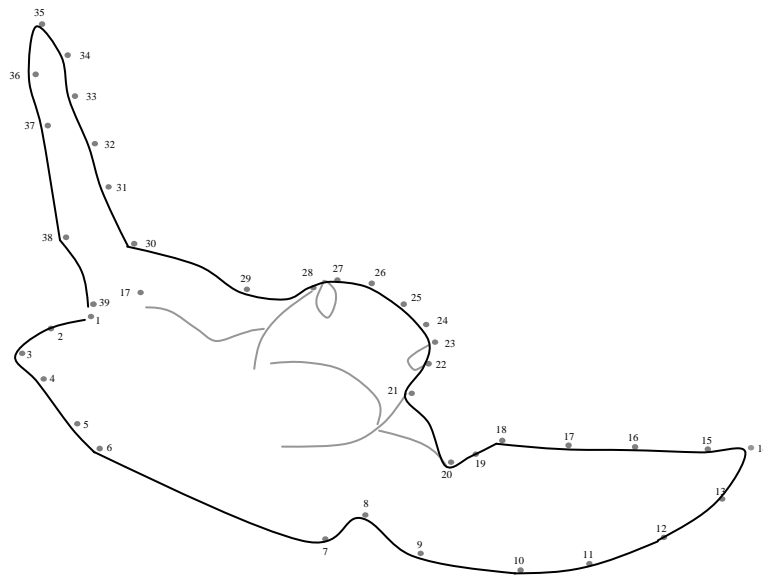
If you take your glasses off during the film, you will see double.

Two different images are shown on the screen at the same time: one for the right eye, the other for the left eye. The polarising lenses in the glasses only let each eye see the image it is meant to see (left or right). Each eye sees the images slightly differently, and as our brain combines the two images into one it thinks that the scene is taking place in 3D.

The film's characters were created by computer-generated images. They are also called "virtual" characters because often the images are not lifelike. They are created using a computer.

- The projection technique that made this film more impressive is the 3D method. It makes it seem that the images are actually close and around us, covering our field of view like in the real world.

In The Video Challenge, we play directly in the game using our own movements rather than using a gamepad to make a character move. We are filmed and the live image of ourselves is inserted straight into the game, so we see our actions on the screen.

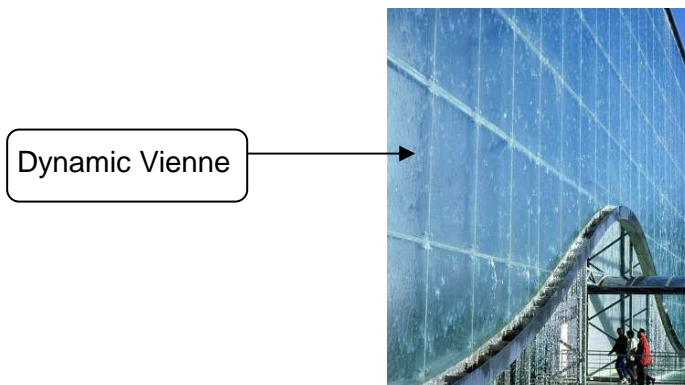
#### 👉 Stage 5




The attraction that takes place in the only theatre of its kind in the world is called Travellers by Air and by Sea.

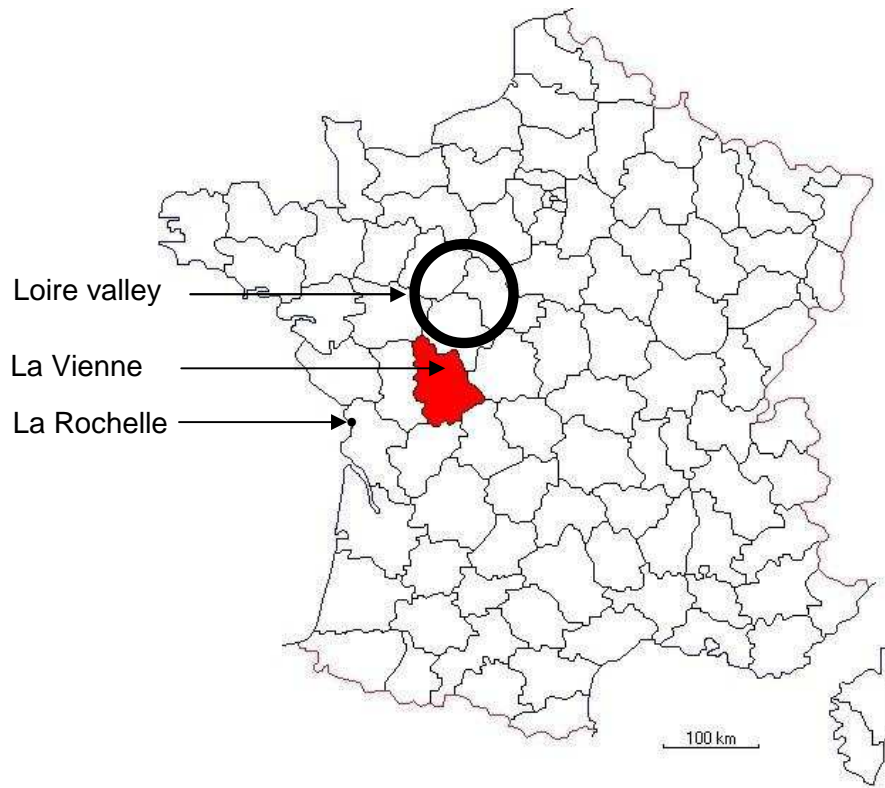
The position of the screens (one in front and the other 65 ft underneath us) makes it seem like we are flying with the birds above the sea.
