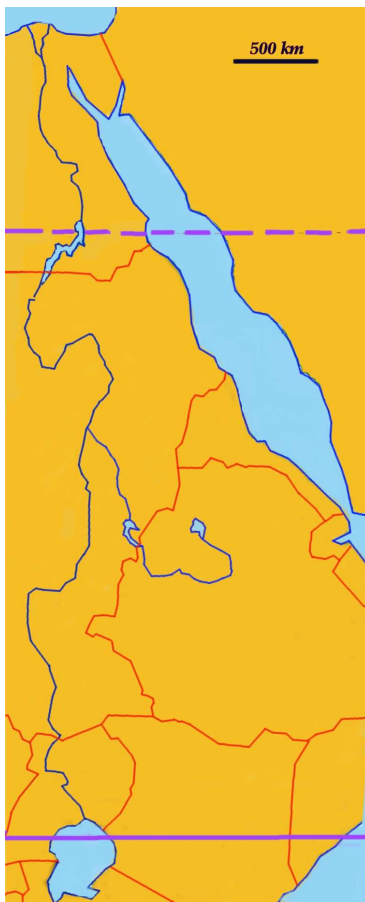

Go to the building shown in the following photo:



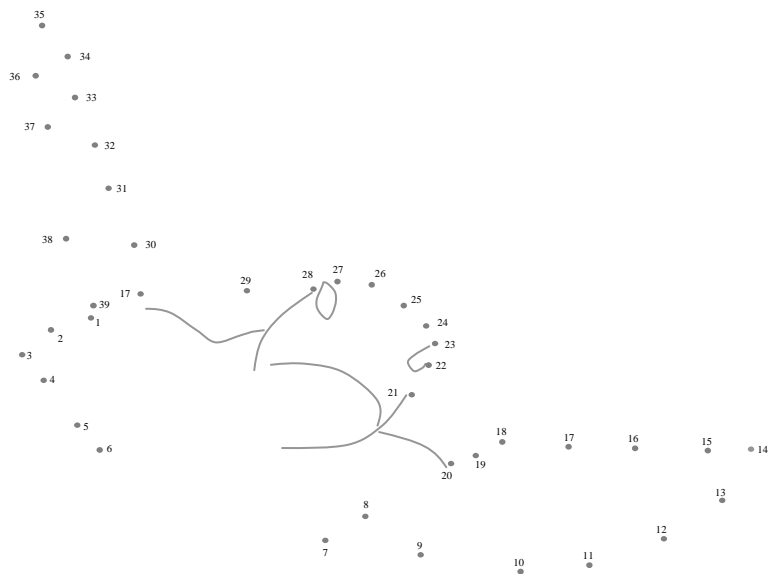
Ⓛ **Clue:** *it is not a virtual building!*
