- Pursuant to decree no.2016-1311 dated 4 October 2016 regarding the departmental safety and accessibility advisory committee,
- Pursuant to the order dated 8st of December 2014 establishing the technical measures intended to make establishments admitting members of the public and facilities that are open to the public accessible to handicapped persons at the time of construction, creation or modification, in application of article R162-8 to R162-13 and R164-1 to R164-6 of the building and housing code,
- Pursuant to the amended order from the Minister of the Interior dated 25 June 1980 setting forth safety regulations against the risks of fire and panic in establishments admitting members of the public (attractions, boutiques, restaurants and Hotel du Futuroscope),
- Pursuant to the notices from the departmental sub-committee for access for the disabled,
- Pursuant to the notices of the departmental sub-committee for fire and panic safety measures in establishments admitting members of the public and in high-rise buildings,
- Pursuant to the order dated 19 October 2001 concerning the hygiene of food served directly to consumers.

With regard to current applicable legislation, I the undersigned, Mr Franck DELHOMME, safety director, hereby testify that Parc du FUTUROSCOPE is subject to regular inspections by the departmental safety committee and is in full possession of the requisite authorisations to allow it to operate all of its attractions and reception facilities. From 2018, Parc du FUTUROSCOPE is carrying the label "Safety-Site" issued by the Home Affairs Ministry attesting its degree of security.
